

Endeavour Safe Haven Project is a unique and specialised support service for families living in the Bolton area who are recovering from domestic abuse. A referral into Safe Haven will only be with your consent and will enable you to have a Safe Haven Support Worker who will help you move on with your life.

We know that domestic abuse can affect people in lots of different ways and your Safe Haven Worker will support you on your own specific journey into living your new life free from abuse.

Safe Haven offers home based support and we can help with your recovery from both the physical and also the emotional impact of domestic abuse.
